

Please bring the weapon(s) that you wish to have on your permit (up to three). The weapons must be registered. All weapons should be larger than a 22 caliber, and no larger than a 45 caliber. Bring at least 100 rounds per weapon, although the qualifications will consist of 50 rounds. This way, we can use 50 as practice, if needed.

The weapon(s) must not have any modification to it (no addition of laser sights, flashlight accessories, trigger pull modifications, etc). The weapon must be the same as purchased from the manufacturer (out of the box). Night sights are ok.

Please bring your cleaning kit, with the attachments for all calibers which you will qualify with.

Bring a holster for at least one weapon. For semi-automatics, be sure to have 2 magazines with you, and for revolvers, be sure to have a speed-loader with you. Bring your eye and ear protection. It is best if you bring the holster(s) which you will be using for concealment, although it is not required.

Dress appropriately for the weather conditions. I recommend a ball-cap for the outdoor live fire qualifications. I would avoid wearing shorts, tank tops or low cut shirts (warm, expended casings). It is best to bring some old (but comfortable) shoes which you don't mind getting dirty, for the outdoor shooting (dirt range). Your vehicle will get a bit dusty as well. You may wish to bring a fold up chair.

Be sure to have a valid CA Driver's License or ID card with you. Your identity will be verified with this.

I am available to assist you with your CCW application, and you are welcome to bring it with you.

The location of the classroom training facility is: 605 G Street #120, Lincoln, CA 95648.

We will begin at the training facility, and drive to the outdoor range for live fire (just 5 minutes north of the classroom). The range fee is \$10.00. It can be a bit hot at the range in summer months, so bring some bottled water.

The training facility is located at the corner of Hwy 65 (also known as G Street) and 6th street, on the north-east corner, directly across the street from the car wash. The entrance faces Hwy 65, and is 2 doors down from Dillian's Bar & Grill (in the Lincoln Plaza building). There is a clock tower on the top of the structure.

There is plenty of free parking available. You may park in the City parking lot, which is located at the corner of 6th and F streets, or there may be on street parking available as well.

There are plenty of restaurants nearby, including Subway, Mr. Pickles, Mexican deli, McDonald's, Burger King, a Bar & Grill, Chinese food, and some great Mom & Pop Diner's within walking distance.

Be sure that your guns are unloaded, and securely locked in a case. Please do not bring in firearms until instructed to do so.

There is a gun store/FFL just two blocks down from the training facility (open Wed-Sat 10am – 5pm).

At the beginning of the course, you can pay with cash, check or charge.
